Who have been your personal heroes?

Why makes them your heroes?

What do you believe are the characteristics we admire in other people?

Thinking back to Sunday's message – what challenged the way you think, bothered you, inspired you, or otherwise was significant to you?

Read GALATIANS 2:20.

What does it mean to be crucified with Christ?

What do you think it means to live a crucified life?

How challenging do you find this in your own life? Why do you think that is?

Read LUKE 9:23-25.

If you were explaining these verses to someone, how would you explain this passage to them?

Why would these verses be incredibly challenging among people who have more money and possessions?

Do you think it is easier for those who have little in the way of money and/or possessions? Explain.

Why do you believe it is important for churches to explain verses like this to their people regularly?

Are these verses frightening or challenging to you personally?

What is one thing that is out of your comfort zone that you believe the Lord is challenging you to do?
Have you taken any steps to follow His challenge?
